Bouncer Operating Instructions

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FOLLOW THESE RULES:

1. Adult supervision is required at all times.
2. For 15' Jump, 8-10 Children at one time, or 5-6 Adults. For 13' Jump, 5-7 Children. For 10' Jump, 3-4 Children, For 8' Jump, 3-4 Toddlers.
3. Jumpers should be the same age group and relative size.
4. Users must remove shoes, eye glasses, and jewelry. Empty all pockets of any hard or sharp objects.
5. No Food, Drink, Gum, or Candy in unit.
6. **No Silly String in or around unit.**
7. Unit must be anchored down properly with Anchors provided.
8. Area required must be flat & free of animal droppings, stones, stumps, etc.
9. For the safety of all users, all outdoor use must have GFCI Ground Fault protection. All inside use must have proper grounded outlets (3-prong).
10. For the safety of all users, Extension cord must be for outside use, grounded, (3-prong) & **Max. 50' Long. ***DO NOT ADD TO THE LENGTH OF EXTENSION CORD.**
11. If unit becomes soft or starts to deflate, exit jumpers immediately and then check connections.
12. Any persons under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or acting in a rowdy or dangerous fashion must be removed immediately.
13. If severe weather should arise, close ride immediately.
14. **DO NOT LEAVE UNIT DEFLATED IN RAIN OR OVERNIGHT. ROLL UP UNIT THEN COVER WITH TARP WHEN NOT IN USE.**

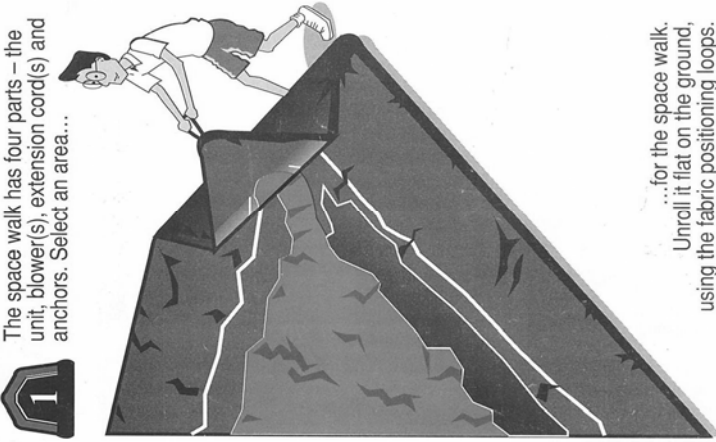

SETTING IT UP

The space walk has four parts – the unit, blower(s), extension cord(s) and anchors. Select an area...



...for the space walk.
Unroll it flat on the ground, using the fabric positioning loops.

Using only one 50 foot extension cord for each blower.

Do NOT ADD TO THE

50' Extension Cord



Plug each blower into a 115 volt electrical outlet. Make sure the outlet has either a SLO-BLO 20 AMP fuse or 30 AMP fuse circuit. The blower should be the only thing plugged into that circuit. If two blowers are required they must be on separate circuits.

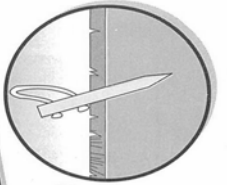
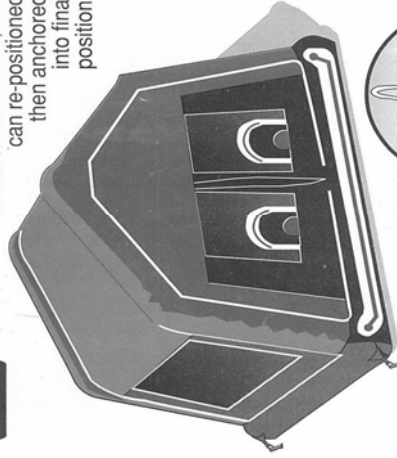
Using straps (bundle ties) provided, tie all vents and air release stubs in the closed position.



Slip the six foot tube in the rear of the space walk snugly around the blower outlet and secure it with the draw string.



Inflation takes five minutes. The blower runs continuously while the space walk is in use. Once inflated, unit can re-positioned then anchored into final position.



Space Walk must be anchored

Hammer wood stake into ground and then tie rope from unit to anchor. Stake should be within 12 inches from unit to prevent tripping. To test the anchor pull up with a firm lifting force to assure the it is secure.

TAKING IT DOWN

Remove riders from the unit and unplug blower. Disconnect the blower from the unit and open the air vents.

CAUTION: Do not jump on partially inflated unit.



When the unit is deflated, fold each side to the center allowing one side to overlap the other.

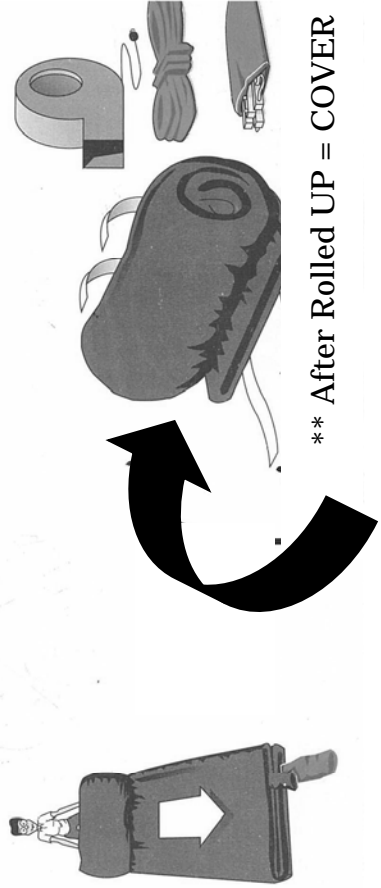
Next, fold in half again to form single width.

Do NOT Leave Spread Open In Yard when NOT IN USE!



Starting from the door, roll the unit toward the rear pushing any excess air from the space walk.

Place tie straps under the unit; tuck in the tubes and tie the bundle so it is secure.

SAFETY

- 1) BLOWER MUST HAVE BACK PRESSURE, MEANING IT MUST BE ATTACHED TO AN INFLATABLE OR DUCT TO AVOID ANY DAMAGE TO MOTOR.
- 2) KEEP CHILDREN AWAY FROM UNIT AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN OPERATION AND/OR PLUGGED IN.
- 3) DO NOT PUT FINGERS OR OTHER OBJECTS IN UNIT WHILE IN OPERATION AND/OR PLUGGED IN.
- 4) DO NOT OPERATE IN POOLED WATER TO AVOID ELECTRIC SHOCK.
- 5) MOTOR MUST BE KEPT DRY AT ALL TIMES. IF UNIT BECOMES WET, THOROUGHLY DRY BEFORE NEXT OPERATION.
- 6) INDOOR USE: USE ONLY WITH A GROUNDED PLUG AND/OR EXTENSION CORD TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK OR FIRE. REMEMBER NEVER TO USE A CORD WITH ANY KIND OF DAMAGE OR WEAR.
- 7) MAKE SURE THE POWER SOURCE IS SUFFICIENT TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE BLOWER.
- 8) KEEP AIR INTAKES CLEAR AT ALL TIMES TO AVOID CLOGGING OR BLOCKING IN ORDER TO PREVENT OVERHEATING THE UNIT. BLOCKING THE AIR INTAKES COULD RESULT IN A FIRE OR ELECTRICAL HAZARDS.
- 9) DO NOT REMOVE ANY SCREENS OR SAFETY GUARDS FROM THIS UNIT TO PREVENT INJURY TO PERSONS, AND TO AVOID OBJECTS FROM COMING IN CONTACT WITH THE BLOWER WHEEL. UNIT DAMAGE IN THIS MANNER WILL VOID YOUR WARRANTY.
- 10) DO NOT OPERATE UNIT CLOSE TO ANY DANGEROUS AREAS, SUCH AS EXPLOSIVE GASES, FLAMMABLES, HEATERS AND VENTILATED ENVIRONMENT, WHICH MAY RESULT IN EXPLOSIONS OR ELECTRICAL HAZARDS.
- 11) DO NOT USE ANY FORM OF SPEED CONTROL DEVICE AS DOING SO MAY RISK INJURY OR FIRE.
- 12) ALWAYS PLACE BLOWER ON A SMOOTH AND LEVELED SURFACE FOR SAFE OPERATION.
- 13) DO NOT OPERATE IN STACKED POSITION.
- 14) DO NOT USE UNIT IF DAMAGED.
- 15) BEFORE CLEANING OR SERVICING UNPLUG UNIT.
- 16) ALL BLOWERS IN OPERATION MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES.

INTRODUCTION TO B-AIR

YOUR NEW B-AIR BLOWER HAS A 1 HP HIGH EFFICIENCY MOTOR, WHICH HAS STATE OF THE ART CONSTRUCTION AND SCREENS ON OPEN VENTS FOR SAFETY AND LONG LIFE. THE HANDLES ARE DESIGNED FOR EASY CARRYING AND THE UNITS ARE ALSO STACKABLE FOR SPACE EFFICIENCY.

OPERATION/USE

THIS HIGH PRESSURE UNIT IS INTENDED TO INFLATE LARGE INFLATABLE PLAY STRUCTURES, BUT IS SUITABLE FOR A VARIETY OF OTHER APPLICATIONS.

- A) CAREFULLY PLACE THE B-AIR UNIT ON STABLE FLAT DRY SURFACE-KEEPING CHILDREN AWAY.
- B) ATTACH AN INFLATABLE TUBE AROUND THE EXHAUST OPENING USING STRAPS OR ANY OTHER FORM OF TIGHTENER.
- C) PLUG CORD INTO A GROUNDED GFCI OUTLET ONLY.
- D) TURN ON SWITCH AND MAKE SURE IT IS OPERATING CORRECTLY.
- E) ALL BLOWERS IN OPERATION MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES.
